is now requesting our TAX-ID number, which we have. Jeff noted that we may need to finish some work on our non-profit documentation.


## 2024 Activities

The drag strip Volvo 240 Wagon was there again. David shared our Volvo club card with him and invited him to the Gilmore. Theresa and Ian Brade from the West Michigan Saab Club, Roger and Lisa Moffat, lead on the Franklin/Air Cooled Group who is hosting the event at the Gilmore Car Museum and has graciously invited us to join their annual meet. Roger discussed how their group functions, which is VERY low-key. Our partnering / joining their group in 2022 went very smoothly, and we wish to continue the same. The Air-Cooled Group will be across from the diner, the Volvo Group will be south of the G Barn/Shell Station in the same place as 2022. Al Bulgrin will design/lay the field and will consult with Theresa on the SAABs. The SAABs will be between the Cadillac and Pierce Arrow buildings and expecting 25-50 which we believe can be accommodated in that one area. There was discussion of overflow, moving west, and even to the circle/track, which we do not believe will be needed. Our clubs are very grateful to the H.H. Franklin/Air Cooled Group for allowing us to attend their Saturday event. It's truly a win/win. We also invited Doug and Terri Klink from the air-cooled group who designed our t-shirts two years ago. We are combining the biennial Gilmore Car Museum show with Saab-owning friends and group members. David has been keeping in touch with Ken Fischang/staff at the Gilmore Car Museum regarding our meeting. This year, the cost is \$20 per car, which is a great deal! We talked about ideas to improve between now and June. David has contacted six dealers in Michigan, five in Illinois, one in Ohio, and one in Ontario for donations. Suggest other sponsors and break up into volunteers to get goody bags. Theresa contacted Hagerty who will be providing her with bags and will provide the point of contact to David Irvine.
- David has contacted Doug and Terri Clink who made the yellow T-shirts for us in 2022. We had almost 50 made and did a great job of planning sizes in advance... we sold out with only a few left one small and a few XXL ©. Doug and Terri consulted with the group at our dinner and will provide the design/setup for printing the shirts. The group gave some basic instructions for design and decided to let the designer do the shirts, not the committee ©. The cost would be approximately \$20 each. There will be a slight upcharge for any 2X or 3X. This is their first design for our Volvos at the Gilmore IX. Theresa Brade is discussing a design for shirts for the SAAB group to discuss options for their own T-shirts.




#### Actionable items:
